Make an impression

Seeking creative inspiration? This *belle époque* villa in Grasse, half an hour from Cannes, was the home of **Mary Cassatt** during the First World War. Dubbed one of the “*trois grandes dames*” of impressionism, alongside Marie Bracquemond and Berthe Morisot, the Pennsylvania-born painter was the only American officially associated with the group. She entertained luminaries such as Renoir and Degas, her mentor, at the property.

The 3,700 sq ft home, which has five bedrooms, Mediterranean gardens, a pool and panoramic sea views, is on the market for €2.49m (£2.1m).
